△ Instructions for the Manuscripts and Presentations

All papers accepted for presentation at ICIFS'2023 will be published in the **Journal "Notes on Intuitionistic Fuzzy Sets"** (ISSN: 1310-4926, e-ISSN: 2367-8283) and will be available online under Open Access (CC BY 4.0 License), with DOI numbers. Papers should not exceed 20 A4 pages and should comply with the paper template of the Journal "Notes on Intuitionistic Fuzzy Sets" and the Journal's *Publication Ethics Policy*. Manuscripts will be subject to rigorous peer review by two independent reviewers.

Participants who are willing to attend physically in the conference will be **recorded and live streamed** for those who attend the conference online. Participants who are willing to attend online are requested to prepare and submit in advance a **back-up video of their presentation** (which will be streamed in case of any technical problems), and stay online to answer any live questions from the audience.
